

Using Tapestry in Primary

Welcome to Tapestry!

Your child's school use the online learning journal Tapestry to follow your child's learning. By using Tapestry, the school can also set up an account for you to access your child's journal too. This means that you will be able to see the things they have been up to during the day giving you the opportunity to support your child's learning further when at home.

Once the school is ready to share access with you, they will need your name and email address so that they can set up your account. They may give you a password so that you can log in, or they may send out an activation link so that you can create your own password, so keep an eye out for it, including in your spam folder!

There are many different things that Tapestry can offer – most of which are currently available through a browser at the address above. There is also an app available for Android and iOS devices; this app can be used to upload observations, as well as view Activities and Memos.

Other features can only be seen on the browser though, so don't forget to keep checking on the browser for all the amazing things that are being shared with you!

Reports

If a report is shared with you on Tapestry, it will provide you with information about how your child is working within the Early Years Framework .

The reports may contain the age band that your child is currently working within, as well as any next steps that the teacher has identified to help your child make continued progress. Reports are available through the browser along the top menu.

Memos

These are a way for the teachers to get a message to you without it entering your child's journal. They might use this to let you know about any trips or special events that are coming up, or to remind you about those dress up days! You can leave a comment on a memo, but please note, these will be seen by all other relatives of children tagged in the memo. Memos are available through the browser along the top menu, or can be viewed in the latest update of the app.

Observations

Observations and their assessments can be about anything that your child does, and the teacher will make a judgement based on those observations altogether – not just a single one. Therefore, if you are able to add things that your child does at home, such as talking about the changes in the weather, completing an activity set for homework or achieving something in a sports club, these will all help the teacher make an accurate judgement. The assessment that you might see will be from the National Curriculum statements from the year your child is working in. You may also see a 'tier' showing how secure they are in that statement. These are set up by your child's school and can be discussed further with the teacher.

With Tapestry, you can easily add your own observations using the app or the browser.

Activities

Your child's teacher can provide an activity for your child to try, using the Activities feature. You will have the opportunity to reply with an observation. By replying this way, the teacher will be able to quickly link it to the activity. Your reply will be through an observation, making it easy for you to find too.

It is possible to ask questions to the teacher about the task, but please be aware that any questions asked will be seen by any other relatives of children who are tagged in that same activity. Activities are available through the browser along the top menu, or can be viewed in the latest update of the app.

Details about the app

If you have an iOS or Android device, then from your app store you will be able to find the Tapestry Mobile app. The app is a quick and convenient way to access observations, activities and memos that have been added for your child, as well as for you to add things from home.

New features are also being phased in, so do keep your app up to date to access these.
